This Cookie Policy describes how Riggs Asset Management Company, Inc. (referred to herein as “our,” “us,” or “we”) collects and uses cookies about you through our website (“Site”).

What are Cookies?

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that is downloaded on to your computer when you visit a website. Cookies are used by many websites and can do a number of things, e.g., remembering your preferences, recording what you have put in your shopping basket, and counting the number of people looking at a website.

How do we use Cookies?

We use the following types of cookies for the reasons described below. These cookies may be set by us or a third party service provider to perform the functions described below:

- **Required:** These cookies and tracking technologies are required to help our website work correctly. For example, these cookies allow you to navigate our Website and use essential features, including secure areas.
- **Analytical purposes:** Analytical cookies allow us to recognize, measure and track visitors to our Site. This helps us to improve and develop the way our Site works, for example, by determining whether Site visitors can find information easily, or by identifying the aspects of the Site that are of the most interest to them.
- **Functional purposes:** Functional purpose cookies store information that is needed by our applications to process and operate. For example, where transactions or requests within an application involve multiple workflow stages, cookies are used to store the information from each stage temporarily, in order to facilitate completion of the overall transaction or request.
- **Advertising:** These cookies and tracking technologies allow us to deliver content, including advertisements, relevant to your specific interests. This content may be delivered on our Websites or on third party websites or services. They allow us to understand and improve the relevancy of our advertisements. They may track personal information, including your IP address.
